

Union Minister takes stock of healthcare facilities in Reasi

REASI, Oct 14: As part of public outreach programme launched by the Central Government for the Union Territory of J&K, Union Minister of State for Health & Family Welfare, Dr. Bharati Pravin Pawar today took stock of different healthcare facilities available in district Reasi.

During the outreach program, Dr. Bharati inspected District Hospital Reasi and stressed on institutional deliveries and Ayushman Bharat Health Scheme benefits for the common masses. During the inspection, Director Health, Dr. Saleem-ul-Rehman gave a detailed Power Point Presentation of various facilities available at District Hospital and other health institutions of the district, the health indicators, details of the OPDs, IPDs, status of the major operations conducted, details of the

5 DySPs posted as Chief Investigating Officers

JAMMU, Oct 14: Five Dy Superintendents of Police, who were under orders of adjustment, have been transferred and posted as Chief Investigating Officers in different districts.

As per an order in this regard, issued today by DGP Dilbag Singh, Massof Ahmad has been posted in District Kupwara, Shafeeq Ahmad in district Sopore, Muhammad Akbar in district Baramulla, Manzoor Ahmad in district Budgam and Nisar Ahmad in district Ganderbal.

Meanwhile, according to a separate order, four Dy Superintendents of Police, posted in Police components Jammu and Srinagar, have been designated as Chief Investigating Officers in addition to their own duties.

They are; Vaseem Mehmood (DySP PC Jammu), Sunil Singh (DySP PC Jammu), Syed Sleet Shah (DySP PC Srinagar) and Himayun Muzammil (DySP PC Srinagar).

They shall function under the supervision of concerned Superintendents of Police, Police Component.

Dr Jitendra offers to adopt 60 TB patients from his constituency

NEW DELHI, Oct 14 : Union Minister and MP from Udhampur-Kathua-Doda Lok Sabha constituency, Dr Jitendra Singh today offered to adopt 60 Tuberculosis patients, that is, 10 patients each from each of the six districts of Kathua, Doda, Udhampur, Reasi, Ramban and Kishtwar respectively.

Sharing this on twitter, Dr Jitendra Singh said , he was trying

a humble contribution to accomplish Prime Minister Narendra Modi's vision of a TB-free India by 2025 and appealed to others too to join this movement. He informed that the concerned Deputy Commissioners of each of the six districts has been formally conveyed the offer with the request to help identify the needy patients requiring support and provide their details, with the help of Chief Medical Officer.

Dr Jitendra Singh called upon

the MLAs, Collectors, DDC Chairman and Members, NGOs, Eminent Personalities, Religious Leaders, civil society, TB Champions and Corporates from his parliamentary constituency to adopt tuberculosis patients as donors through 'Community Support to TB Patients' programme and become 'Nikshay Mitra' taken up as part of Pradhan Mantri TB-Mukt Bharat Abhiyaan.

Dr Jitendra Singh recalled that

President of India, Droupadi Murmu launched the Pradhan Mantri TB Mukta Bharat Abhiyaan on 9th September and urged citizens to work collectively towards TB elimination in spirit of Jambhagidari on a war footing.

Dr Jitendra Singh expressed hope that India will eliminate the high-burden infectious disease by 2025, five years ahead of the global goal of 2030. This vision was first articulated by the Prime Minister at the Delhi End TB

Summit in March 2018.

Under the programme, one can adopt individual TB patients or a group of TB patients via Nikshay 2.0 website (community support.nikshay.in) and sponsor their treatment or nutrition, a nutrition basket or offer a job to their family members. They can adopt them for six months, one year, two or three years. Among 13.51 lakh TB patients in the country, over 10 lakh TB patients have given their consent for adoption.
