One killed, another injured in mishaps

JAMMU, Oct 19: One person was killed and another injured in two separate road accidents occurred today at Birkam Chowk, Jammu.

According to the reports, a speeding bus bearing registration number JK02AS-7719 this morning hit and severely injured an unknown man of age about 40 years at Birkam Chowk, near Asia Hotel. The injured man was rushed to Government Medical College and Hospital, Jammu, where he was declared as brought dead by the doctors.

Meanwhile, an unknown vehicle tonight hit a bike and injured its rider severely at Birkam Chowk. The injured bike rider identified as Ravi Kumar, resident of Shakti Nagar, was shifted to Government Medical College and Hospital, Jammu, where his condition was stated to be critical when the last reports came in.
