‘Showcases growing strength in engineering technology’ Highest Rly bridge in Reasi exemplifies

India’s changed work culture: PM

JAMMU, Sept 24: Prime Minister Narendra Modi has said that construction of highest railway bridge in Reasi district (which will connect Kashmir valley with country through rail) showcases India’s growing strength in the field of cutting-edge and engineering technology.

His remarks came in a chapter exclusive devoted to construction of railway bridge in Reasi district which was completed few days back and is highest railway bridge surpassing Eiffel Tower, in the Government’s official magazine.

“This construction work not only showcases India’s growing strength in the field of cutting-edge engineering and technology, but also exemplifies the country’s changed work culture of Sankalp Se Siddhi,” the Prime Minister said in his quote.

In the chapter Chenab Bridge—World’s Highest Railway Bridge Over Chenab’, the Government said the bridge

is 1315 meters in length and involved a cost of Rs 27,949 crore.

“The 359 metre high Chenab Arch is the highest railway bridge in the world. It is 35

metres higher than the Eiffel Tower in Paris (France),” the Government said.

It added that the bridge is made of 28,660 metric tonnes of steels, has a width of 13 meters, and a serviceable period of around 120 years.

“For the first time in the world, with the help of Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO), the bridge has been made blast-proof,” the Government said.

It said the Indian Railways

completed the arch construction of the world’s highest railway bridge over the Chenab river in Jammu and Kashmir. An excellent example of engineering prowess, this bridge makes every countryman feel proud. With the construction of this bridge, distance of hours can now be covered in minutes.

The bridge will help connect Kashmir valley with train with rest of the country.

The Udhampur-Srinagar-Baramulla Railway Link project is the Indian Railways’ among the most challenging works, the officials said.

The bridge forms a crucial link in the 111-km stretch from Katra to Banihal, which is part of the Udhampur-Srinagar-Baramulla section of the Kashmir Railway project, they said.

Mayor, Dy Mayor of JMC resign

JAMMU, Sept 24: At a meeting of J&K BJP here today, the Mayor of Jammu Municipal Corporation (JMC), Chander Mohan Gupta along with Deputy Mayor, Purnima Sharma resigned from their posts and expressed willingness to work for their political party - the BJP.

The meeting which started at 12:30 pm and continued till 2:30 pm at a Club in Jammu city was chaired by BJP J&K president, Ravinder Raina and was attended by BJP J&K Secretary (Organisation), Ashok Koul and former Deputy Chief Minister Kavinder Gupta along with JMC Councillors from BJP.

When contacted, J&K BJP chief, Ravinder Raina told the Excelsior that no name for the

new Mayor and Deputy Mayor has been finalised so far.

“However, the exercise in this regard will start from tomorrow at 3 pm at BJP J&K office where party Councillors will be asked to give their opinion which will be then presented before the senior party leaders to make a consensus,” he further said adding that the process might be finalised in the upcoming

Navratras.

When asked why the present Mayor and Deputy Mayor have been ousted, Raina said that they have not been ousted but their tenure of two and half years, which was set at the time they both assumed their offices, was over much before but still they were allowed to continue as it

was COVID-19 pandemic that time.

“Now as the COVID is over, the Party has decided the change and Mayor along with his Deputy have also agreed to that,” he maintained adding that the duo might be given some responsibility in the party keeping in view the upcoming elections to J&K Legislative Assembly.

Sources informed that BJP Incharge of J&K, Tarun Chugh may chair the meeting of JMC Councillors tomorrow in which their views might be taken to make a consensus on new Mayor and Deputy Mayor.

It is pertinent to mention here that BJP had won the Urban Local Body elections of JMC in 2018 with its 43 candidates getting success along with 18 (Contd on page 6 Col 5)

2 non-local labourers shot at in Pulwama

SRINAGAR, Sept 24: Militants shot and injured two non-local labourers in Kakapora area of South Kashmir’s Pulwama district this evening.

An official said that militants fired upon the labourers - Shamshad son of Islam Shiekh and Faizan Qasri son of Fayaz Qadri of Batya Zila Bihar at Kharpora Ratnipora. The duo was taken to hospital.

Security forces immediately reached the spot and a hunt has been launched in the area against the militants responsible for the attack.

Police have also registered a case and investigations have been taken up.

Security forces had already strengthened security around

the areas where the non-local labourers are residing, especially in the vulnerable areas of Kashmir.

This is not for the first time that the non-local labourers were targeted by the militants in Kashmir. Earlier as well, the militants targeted several non-local labourers across the Valley.

Militants also targeted police officers and political workers and this year so far 17 persons were killed in these attacks. But security forces killed all those militants who were responsible for these targeted killings. So far, over 120 militants were killed in Kashmir.

Security forces are putting more pressure on the remaining

militants, the OGWs and their sympathizers to wipe out militancy from Kashmir.

Director General of Police (DGP) Dilbag Singh yesterday said that Pakistan was playing bloody game in Kashmir through Hurriyat Conference, militants and other anti-peace elements but that has been defeated.

He had said that the Hurriyat Conference and other anti-peace elements used to play a “bloody game” in Kashmir on behalf of their mentors across.

“Almost all the anti-peace elements have been wiped out and those remaining will be cleared off soon,” Singh said.

He had said that a lot of anti-peace elements were wiped out in Kashmir including militants and remaining ones would be cleared soon.

SIA conducts raids across Kashmir in narco-militancy case

SRINAGAR, Sept 24: The State Investigation Agency (SIA) today conducted multiple raids across Kashmir in a narco-militancy case.

The SIA in a statement said that it conducted extensive searches at different locations in Srinagar, Budgam and Kupwara districts today.

These searches were part of an investigation against narco-militants who are financing militancy through smuggling hard drugs from Pakistan and selling it in Jammu and Kashmir and in other parts of the country.

“Equipped with search warrants issued by the Court of

Special Judge, designated under NIA Act (TADA/POTA) Srinagar, house searches were conducted in connection with investigation of case that was registered in Police Station SIA Kashmir.

The statement further stated that the case was registered on receipt of reliable information that a group of persons working as Over Ground Workers (OGWs) for different militant organizations under a well-knit criminal conspiracy hatched with members of militant organizations are involved in border smuggling of narcotic drugs/substance and the proceeds thereof are passed on to the militant organizations for

furtherance of militancy activities in J&K.

“During investigation, it surfaced that militant organizations across the border in order to fuel the militant activities in J&K are adopting various means and methods to provide logistic support to militants in J&K and one of the ways and means is to send consignments of heroin, brown sugar and other contraband substances worth lakhs of rupees and smuggle the same to Valley through their OGWs, conduits and supporters and other militant sympathizers. These consignments of heroin, brown sugar and other

As per law & legal advice, Singhania University established by an Act of State Legislature and recognized u/s 2(f) of the UGC Act, is an autonomous, self-regulated & constitutionally recognized as an apex body for all education including MBBS, MD, MS and other Diploma courses and being a statutory university, separate and distinct from other non-statutory bodies like college/institution is empowered by the authority of law u/s 12A & 22 of the UGC Act to impart degree/diploma/certificate in all courses including all degree & diploma courses which are registerable qualifications. As the autonomy of university is constitutionally protected under Entry 44, List 1, Schedule 7 to the Constitution of India, it is exempted from the regulatory control of any council including National Medical Commission, State Medical Councils & any other authority and as such the degree/diploma/certificate awarded by Singhania University are sui-generis & valid for all intents & purposes.
