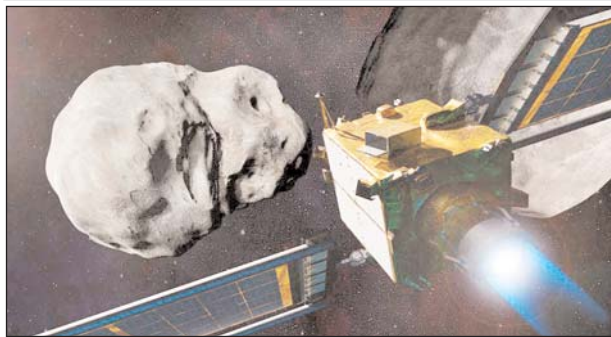

NASA spacecraft crashes into asteroid

nudged safely out of the way, the US space agency said. The Double Asteroid Redirection Test (DART) — the world's first planetary defence technology demonstration — targeted the asteroid moonlet Dimorphos, a small body just 160 metres in diameter. Dimorphos orbits a larger 780-metre asteroid called Didymos. Neither asteroid poses a threat to Earth.

The mission's one-way trip confirmed NASA can successfully navigate a spacecraft to intentionally collide with an asteroid to deflect it, a technique known as kinetic impact, the agency said.

"At its core, DART represents an unprecedented success for planetary defence, but it is also a mission of unity with a real benefit for all humanity," said NASA Administrator Bill Nelson.

"As NASA studies the cosmos and our home planet, we are also working to protect that home, and this international collaboration

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ACB books JEs, others for fictitious bills

According to the ACB, a preliminary enquiry was conducted to look into the allegations of drawal of payments by ACDs, BDOs and REW Doda against fictitious bills, inflated billing for material, drawal of payment against non-existent works in Block Dali of Udhyanpur area of Doda with effect from 2014 to 2018.

During the course of the probe, it was found that a total of 1386 works under different heads have been executed during the period in question. Out of these 1386 works, 118 works were inspected randomly during probe and loss has been detected in 29 works on account of less execution on ground, escalated entries in M.Book etc. besides, 01 work namely construction of P/Path at Gowari to road Panchayat Seel Udhyanpur has been found non-existent. A loss to the tune of Rs 18,75,307 has been found inflicted upon the State exchequer in execution of these 30 works.

The prosecution sought adding further evidence before the trial court. The court in August recalled the order of dismissal of the criminal revision petition of prosecution.

The case is regarding FIR No.24/2003 for offences under Sections 302, 450, 395, 307, 120-B, 326, 427 RPC, 7/27 Arms Act and Section 30 Police Act which came to be registered with Police Station, Zainapora in connection with killing of 24 persons at Village Nadimarg in the year 2003.

Court recalled the order of dismissal of criminal revision filed by the prosecution and treated the said order as a nullity. The prosecution in defence of the case submitted that there are a number of eye-witnesses of the said incident.

Court has been informed that the trial court directed the prosecution to produce evidence and the prosecution could manage to produce 13 witnesses only who have appeared before the trial court for giving statements and the witnesses who have migrated to Jammu did not appear before Court and when prosecution served notices to them they refused to respond the same and the appointment of commission to examine all the eye-witnesses was sought but that application was rejected by the trial court on 09.02.2011.

Govt considering creation of dedicated facilities for accident victims

of the Government of India especially for the treatment of accident victims at District Hospital Kathua.

"With the coming up of All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) at Vijaypur there will not be necessity of creating any more Trauma Centre up to winter capital where all facilities for treatment of accident victims are already available in Government Medical College and Super Speciality Hospital", sources said.

Further, the Health Department is seriously pondering over creating dedicated ICU for accident victims in District Hospital Udhampur and District Hospital Ramban where existing manpower can easily be utilized for their treatment. Likewise, such facilities will be made available in Rajouri-Poonch so that timely treatment is provided to the accident victims.

"Even all out efforts will be made to meet the manpower requirement of existing Trauma Centres and install more equipments, if required", sources further informed, adding "Health Department is of the opinion that instead of creating infrastructure exclusively for the treatment of accident victims in scattered manner it is better to strengthen the existing set-up and this will not put burden of arranging more manpower".

Regarding specialist doctors

170 held in fresh crackdown on PFI

the National Investigation Agency (NIA) arrested 106 leaders and activists of the PFI in 15 States for allegedly supporting terror activities in the country. The NIA is investigating 19 cases involving the PFI.

As police teams fanned out across their respective States today, seemingly synchronised, the action was swift. While 25 people each were arrested in Assam and Maharashtra, 57 were detained in Uttar Pradesh, officials said. The count of those detained in Delhi was 30, Madhya Pradesh was at 21 followed by 10 in Gujarat and six in Pune in Maharashtra. Besides, several people were also arrested in Karnataka.

In Uttar Pradesh, the raids across 26 districts were jointly carried out by the Anti Terrorist Squad, Special Task Force and the local police simultaneously. Documents and evidence were collected, Additional Director General (Law and Order) Prashant Kumar said.

Further action will be taken based on the evidence collected, Kumar said while adding that 57 people were taken into custody.

Cong issues show cause notice to 3 Gehlot loyalists

NEW DELHI, Sept 27:

The Congress today night issued show cause notices to three Ashok Gehlot loyalists - Rajasthan Ministers Shanti Dhariwal and Mahesh Joshi, and Dharmender Rathore - for their "grave indiscipline" and asked them to explain within 10 days why action should not be initiated against them.

The action came two days after 82 MLAs participated in a parallel meeting at Dhariwal's residence in Jaipur laying down conditions to the party and did not attend the official legislature party meeting convened for passing a resolution authorising the Congress chief to appoint a successor to Chief Minister Ashok Gehlot, who was to contest the Congress presidential election.

The party's disciplinary committee sent the notices after Congress observers Mallikarjun Kharge and Ajay Maken submitted their written report to party chief Sonia Gandhi charging the

three state leaders with "gross indiscipline".

The panel's member secretary Tariq Anwar in the notice to Dhariwal, Joshi and Rathore, referred to Maken's report. "Prima facie, the above charges are an act of grave indiscipline. Therefore, this show cause notice is being issued seeking your reply within 10 days as to why disciplinary action not be taken against you as per the provisions of the constitution of the Indian National Congress," the notice to all three leaders said.

Anwar in his notice to Dhariwal said that the observers' report has submitted that as parliamentary affairs minister he sits on the dais and is a prominent speaker at all CLP meetings in Rajasthan.

Apart from issuing statements, he has committed grave indiscipline by hosting a parallel MLAs' meeting at his residence "pressuring them not to attend the official meeting", the notice said. (PTI)
