All transfers to be made through online, only at close of session

School Education Deptt notifies Transfer Policy

JAMMU, Apr 24: The School Education Department today notified its much awaited new Transfer Policy for the employees making it clear that all transfers shall be made through online mode only at the close of academic session while tenure of an employee at a particular school shall depend upon category of the zone.

For the purpose, areas have been categorized as Zone I, II, III, IV and V. The tenure in Zone I, II and III shall ordinarily be three years at a particularly schools while the tenure in Zone IV and V shall be two years and one year, respectively. Tenure for transfer of officers on administrative posts, viz CEOs, Principals, Headmasters, ZEOs and equivalent shall ordinarily be two years with a maximum period of three years. Area falling within Municipal limit of district

headquarter has been categorized as Zone-I while the area outside Municipal limit upto 20 kms from district headquarters falls under Zone-II. The area beyond 20 kms to 40 kms from district headquarters has been categorized as Zone-III. The area beyond 40 kms and above from district headquarters and also where change of residence is required, has been categorized as Zone -IV. Those schools where there is no motorable road and walking
