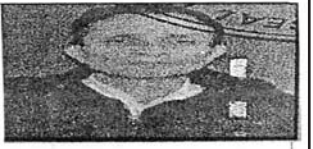

Whereas, superintendence, direction and control of the preparation of electoral rolls, determination of wards, reservation and allotment of seats by formation, for and the conduct of all elections to the Municipal Municipalities is vested in the Chief Electoral Officer under Section 282(1) of the Jammu and Kashmir Municipal Act, 2000:

Whereas, the last general elections to the Municipalities were held in September-October 2018 and the term of these bodies shall expire in November 2023:

Whereas, in terms of Rule 12 of the J&K, Municipal (Election) Rules, 2003, the Electoral Rolls have to be revised in the prescribed manner before the conduct of each General Election to the Municipal Councils/Committees or for any ward to fill a casual vacancy:

Whereas, it has been decided to revise/update the Municipal Electoral Rolls for the following Councils/ Committees with reference to 01-07-2023 as the qualifying date:-

Whereas, under Rule 7 of the Jammu and Kashmir Municipal Election Rules 2003, the Chief Electoral Officer, J&K has notified Electoral Registration Officers (EROs) and Assistant Electoral Registration Officers (AEROs) vide Notification, dated 04-07-2023 issued under endorsement No.CEO-MEOCOME/1/2023/149-52 dated 04-07-2023;

Now therefore, by virtue of this notice, the general public, as well as the political parties, are hereby informed that in order to undertake the Revision of Electoral Rolls with reference to 01-07-2023 as the qualifying date, in respect of the Municipal Councils/Committees of the Union Territory as mentioned above, the schedule for inviting claims and objections regarding addition, deletion, correction and transposition, both manually as well as electronically, is as under:-

Electoral Registration Officers (EROs) concerned shall publish the draft Municipal Electoral Rolls on 1st August 2023 with a notice in Form-2 in accordance with statutory Rules.

The applicants desirous of filing claims/objections may do so before the ERO/AERO manually or by logging on to http://ceo.jk.nic.in/e-filing electronically.

Further,

- i. The place of hearing for the claims/objections received shall be the headquarters of the Electoral Registration Officer (ERO)/Assistant Electoral Registration Officer (AERO);
ii. The date of hearing for the claims/objections shall be notified by the Electoral Registration Officer (ERO) within the period for filing claims and objections and in any case all such hearing shall be completed before 16th August, 2023;
iii. The notice giving an abstract of the claims/objections received by the EROs shall be uploaded on a daily basis on the website of the Chief Electoral Officer, Jammu and Kashmir as also the Deputy Commissioners of the concerned districts;
iv. The Electoral Registration Officer (ERO) shall pass an order on the claims/objections latest by 16-08-2023 and every such order shall be put on the notice board of the ERO immediately on such issuance;
v. Any person aggrieved by the order passed by the ERO shall apply for revision before the ERO within the prescribed statutory period of 5 days;
vi. On receipt of an application for revision as mentioned above, the ERO concerned shall pass appropriate orders and the same shall be final;
vii. Special Camps shall be organised by the Deputy Commissioner at the polling station level, after giving due publicity.
viii. For any assistance in this behalf, the Deputy Commissioner, Electoral Registration Officer (ERO), Assistant Electoral Registration Officer (AERO) or Polling Station Level Officers (PSLOs) of the concerned area may be contacted. The details of Electoral Registration Officer (ERO), Assistant Electoral Registration Officer (AERO) and Polling Station Level Officers (PSLOs) are available in the offices of the Deputy Commissioners of the concerned district and also available on the said website of CEO, J&K (www.ceojk.nic.in). The list of Polling Stations is also available on the said website.
