

Budget proposes 30 pc TDS on net winnings in online games, removes threshold for TDS levy

NEW DELHI, Feb 1: The Government on Wednesday proposed to impose a 30 per cent tax on net winnings from online gaming and also do away with the existing threshold limit of Rs 10,000.

The Budget 2023-24 proposed to introduce two new provisions for Tax Deducted at Source (TDS) on online gaming - levy of 30 per cent on payment of net winnings in a financial year and removal of the current Rs 10,000 threshold for the levy of TDS.

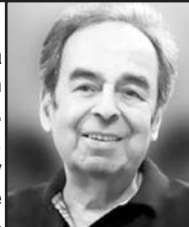

been booked under Section 120-B of the Indian Penal Code at Delhi.

Their arrest was based on the disclosures of Harpreet Singh son of Parmajeet Singh of Hanuman Road Connaught Place, New Delhi, a prime accused in Tarlochan Singh murder case, who was nabbed by Jammu Police team led by SSP Jammu Chandan Kohli from Channi Himmat on December 11 after an encounter.

The SSP Jammu and other police officials had narrow escape in the encounter.

Harpreet Singh, who was also involved in day-light dacoity at the house of Rakesh Aggarwal alias Keshu Baria in Gandhi Nagar, was later taken to New Delhi by Delhi Police on court orders as he was evading arrest in Tarlochan Singh murder case.

Govt expects dividend of Rs 48,000 cr from RBI, PSU banks in FY24

NEW DELHI, Feb 1: The Government expects 17 per cent higher dividend at Rs 48,000 crore from the Reserve Bank of India (RBI), public sector banks and financial institutions in 2023-24.

In current financial year ending March, it aims to garner Rs 40,953 crore from RBI and public sector financial institutions. This is much lower compared to Budget Estimate of Rs 73,948 crore for FY23.

It is to be noted that RBI approved a dividend payment of Rs 30,307 crore to the government post its board meeting in May 2022.

As per the Budget document, dividends from public sector enterprises and other investments have been pegged at Rs 43,000 crore for FY24 as well.

As per the Revised Estimate for FY23, the dividend from public sector enterprises and other investments was higher at Rs 43,000 crore from the Budget Estimate of Rs 40,000 crore. (PTI)

3 held for planting IEDs

Mohammad Jabbar of Dharati, Balakote in Poonch district, Majid Dar of Kheora and Zohaib Khan of Manjakote, both in Rajouri district.

Addressing a press conference in Rajouri, senior police officials said the module was busted after an investigation was launched following the recovery of sophisticated Improvised Explosive Devices (IEDs), having pressure and timer mechanisms, in the district.

"The IEDs were smuggled from across the border to set off explosions at crowded public places and target security vehicles and camps. The arrest of the trio, including the kingpin, prevented nefarious designs of the terror handlers (from being executed)," the police officials said.

An IED planted inside a tiffin box was seized from Kheora locality near Government Medical College (GMC), Rajouri, on January 18 and another IED was found in Budhal area of the district 10 days earlier.

The detection of the IEDs followed a terror attack in Rajouri's Dhangri village in early January that claimed seven lives and injured 14.

"After the recovery of the IEDs on January 8 and 18, it was clear that the terrorists were looking for another major strike to harm common people. Investigation was speeded up and the first accused, Majid Dar of Kheora, was arrested," the officials said.

They said Dar's questioning led to the arrest of Zohaib Khan of Manjakote and Mohammad Jabbar of Dharati village of Balakote, who turned out to be the kingpin of the module.

Two more sophisticated IEDs were recovered on the basis of disclosures made by them, the officer said, adding that they are in remand till February 10 and more arrests and recoveries are expected at their disclosure.

"Jabbar, whose residence falls beyond the border fence, is directly linked with the IED. He is physically handicapped and was taking directions and guidance from terror handlers sitting across the border," the police officials said.

2 Polish skiers killed, 21 rescued from Gulmarg avalanche

national and two local guides went to Affarwat for skiing this morning. "A snow avalanche struck Hapatkhud Kangdori around 12.30 pm," he said.

The SSP said that Baramulla police mobilized joint rescue teams of the Police, Army and Tourism department who rushed to the spot and started the rescue operation using all available equipment.

"During the rescue operation, 19 foreign nationals and 2 local guides were safely rescued," he said.

A police spokesman identified them as Ekaterina, Maxim, Vladimir, Vasily, Engine, Leo, Nikita, Mastryukov, Anna Chornyak, residents of Russia and Rafat Kaqmarren, Narcin Wieklux, Eukasz Potaczewick, Tukasz Pasek, Katarzyna Filip, Marcin Raczynk, Bartomie Szkop, Bartosz Domagata, Adrian Anirowski and Macie Kowalczyk, residents of Poland, a foreign guide Bartos from the same country and two local guides Fayaz Ahmad Sheikh and Mushtaq Ahmad Mir from Tangmarg.

"Unfortunately, two foreign nationals identified as Krzysztof, 43, and Adam Grzech, 45, both from Poland lost their lives in the avalanche. The dead bodies of both the foreign nationals have been recovered and shifted to hospital for medico legal formalities," the SSP said.

Snow avalanches are frequent in higher reaches of Kashmir during January and February, especially after fresh snowfall.

The last big avalanche in Gulmarg was on February 8, 2010 when 17 soldiers in an Army camp were killed.
