NEW DELHI, Feb 14: A Delhi court today awarded an over seven-year jail term to four operatives of Al-Qaeda in the Indian Subcontinent (AQIS), a wing of Al-Qaeda, for conspiracy to commit terror activities across the country and recruiting members for the militant outfit.

Govt notifies ITR forms

CBDT has notified the income tax return forms for Assessment Year 2023-24 (for income earned in 2022-23) quite early, which would help taxpayers prepare their income returns early this year. Last year, such forms were notified in the first week of April.
"Early notification of ITR forms would give ample time to all the stakeholders, including the e-filing portal, third-party software companies, taxpayers, and tax professionals. This year, software vendors can use this extra time for an early implementation of excel utility and third-party software for filing ITRs," Mohan added.

PM, HM, LG pay tribute to Pulwama martyrs

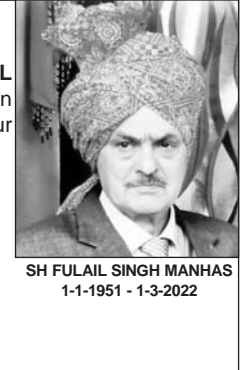
