NIA raids in 3 States

bomb blast in a car laden with explosives in front of Kottai Eswaran Temple in Coimbatore district in Tamil Nadu.

The accused, Jamesha Mubeen, after swearing "Bayath" (allegiance) to the ISIS, was planning to carry out a suicide attack on October 23 last year and cause extensive damage to the temple complex with the intention to strike terror among a section of the society, the agency spokesperson said.

Coimbatore case were carried out in 32 places in Tamil Nadu and Kerala -- Coimbatore (14), Trichy (1), Nilgiris (2), Tirunelveli (3), Tuticorin (1), Chennai (3), Thiruvannamalai (1), Dindigul (1), Mayiladuthurai (1), Krishnagiri (1), Kanyakumari (1), Tenkasi (1) and Ernakulam (1).

The agency carried out searches in eight places in connection with the Mangaluru case -- Tiruppur (2) and Coimbatore (1) of Tamil Nadu, Ernakulam (4) of Kerala, and Mysuru (1) of Karnataka.

The second case relates to a pressure cooker bomb blast that took place in a moving auto-rickshaw in Mangaluru City in Karnataka on November 19 last year.

The blast occurred when the accused was carrying the improvised Explosive Device for planting it in a public place.

The searches led to the seizure of a large number of digital devices and Rs 4 lakh in cash, the spokesperson said, adding further investigations in these two cases are on.

The searches in Tamil Nadu began by 5 am amid local police security and went on for several hours. The locations searched include the residence of a Software Engineer in Tiruchirappalli and the house of a father and son duo Mayiladuthurai who work as car drivers in Muscat.

In Tirunelveli district, Aadhar card, SIM and a mobile phone were seized following searches. In Tenkasi, the house of a woman who was in touch over phone with some suspects in the Coimbatore case was searched. In Chennai, sleuths arrived at the house of a man that had been searched earlier too in connection with the Coimbatore blast. Following searches, he told reporters that there was no need for him to hide, delete messages on his phone or change the device since he has no ties with anyone who are on the NIA's radar. (PTI)

Ladakh Groups hold protest at Delhi for four-point agenda

Ladakh gathered at the 18th-century observatory, a stone's throw away from the Parliament building, and said they hoped their voice would reach the Government.

"Our traditions, ethnic identity, resources and security are at stake today. Our demand is very simple, we want democracy to be restored in Ladakh by giving it Statehood, and to be brought under the sixth schedule of Constitution," said Thupstan Chhewang, a former BJP MP.

He said Ladakh is an ecologically sensitive area and development activities without consulting locals will be harmful.

"A big solar power project has been planned, but the area earmarked is the area of nomadic people who are known for producing Pashmina. It will displace them because their rich pastures will go. In addition, it will also impact the environment in the area," he said.

"If the people of Ladakh have a say in the decision making, we will decide what kind of industries should be set up," he said.

Environmental activist and educator Sonam Wangchuk

accused the BJP of renegeing on its promise of including Ladakh under the sixth schedule.

"In 2020, when Hill Council elections were held, the BJP had promised Sixth Schedule status. We are very thankful to the BJP as they gave Union Territory status to Ladakh... Was it a promise or not? Does the election manifesto mean anything or not?" he asked.

"We made them win the Hill Council, they deserved it because they gave us a Union Territory. It was a promise, then they went silent on it, and now it is a crime to even talk about it. If youth in Ladakh speak of the Sixth Schedule, they are detained," he said.

The absence of Ladakh MP Jamiyang Tsering Namgyal from the protest site was also pointed out by some.

Leader of Opposition in Ladakh Autonomous Hill Development Council, Leh and Councillor from Lower Leh, Tsering Namgyal said the MP should raise their demands in Parliament.

"Digvijay Singh raised the issue of Sixth Schedule status to

Ladakh, this issue should have been raised by our MP. Rahul Gandhi also tried to bring an adjournment motion on the Ladakh issue. It is the duty of our MP to talk about Sixth Schedule," Namgyal said.

"There is anger among people, they are unable to understand why Ladakh was made into a Union Territory... Was it done to put us under a bureaucratic regime?" he asked.

Former Kargil MLA Asgar Ali Karbalai said Statehood for Ladakh was important as it is a sensitive region which shares borders with both Pakistan and China.

"We have protected the borders with our blood... Today we are in Delhi, shouting that we need protection and security," he said.

"If Sikkim can get Statehood, why not Ladakh," he added.

Politician and activist Sajid Hussain said they hope Government would take note of their demands and listen to them.

"Leh Apex Body and Kargil Democratic Alliance are holding this protest jointly. We are raising

a four-point agenda, under which our demands are Statehood for Ladakh, Sixth Schedule under Constitution, job reservation, a separate Public Service commission for Ladakh, and two Parliamentary seats for Leh and Kargil," he said.

Ladakh was carved into a Union Territory without legislation when Articles 370 and 35A were abrogated, and Jammu and Kashmir was bifurcated into two Union Territories.

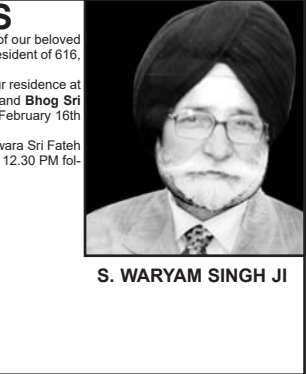
Over the last two years, protests have been held in both Leh and Kargil demanding protection of the interests of the people of Ladakh.

In January this year, the Home Ministry constituted a high-powered committee headed by Minister of State Nityanand Rai to "ensure protection of land and employment" for the people of Ladakh.

The two bodies from Leh and Kargil, however, rejected the committee, and decided not to attend any meeting conducted under its aegis, saying its mandate did not mention the issues raised by them.
