NOTIFICATION

Whereas, the Jammu & Kashmir Services Selection Board (JKSSB) received various Indents/requisitions from the Administrative Departments for the Posts of Junior Assistant/Cashier/Clerk/Store Attendant/Cadrex Clerk/Computer-cum-Junior Assistant/Welfare Organizer for making direct recruitment; and

02. Whereas, the above Indents, 39 in number from 22 departments, comprising of 210 Items, included a total number of 1534 posts as per the above nomenclature, with the requisite qualification/s in respect of the 1511 posts as under:
"Graduation from any recognized university with knowledge of type writing having speed not less than of 35 words per minute and six month's Certificate Course in Computer Applications from any recognized Institute."

03. Whereas, in respect of the remaining 23 posts of Welfare Organizer/Jr. Assistant, belonging to Home Department, the requisite qualification is as under:

"i. Should be deemed to be Graduate from Defense Forces/any recognized University with knowledge of type writing having not less than 35 words speed per minute.
ii. Should be an Ex-Servicemen retired JCO/NCO.
iii. Should bear an exemplary character at the time of retirement from defense services.
iv. Should have six months Certificate Course in Computer Applications from recognized Institute.
v. Should qualify entrance test as per prescribed test.
vi. Should be medical category AYE (SHAPE-1)."

04. Whereas, the category-wise break-up for these 1534 posts (Annexure-Z), belonging to various cadres/departments, after careful cross-check with the indents/advertisements, works out to be as under:

05. Whereas, the JKSSB, vide Notification No.04 of 2020 dated 16.12.2020, No.05 of 2020 dated 24.12.2020, No.06 of 2020 dated 29.12.2020 & No.07 of 2020 dated 31.12.2020 & Notification No.01 of 2021 dated 03.02.2021, No.02 of 2021 dated 26.03.2021 & No.03 of 2021 dated 04.06.2021, advertised these posts as per the category-wise break-up given hereinabove, under various Items, for seeking applications from the eligible candidates; and

06. Whereas, in terms of the method of recruitment notified for the posts of Jr. Assistants, while 80% weight-age is earmarked to the performance of the candidates in the Written Test, the Skill/Type Test shall carry 20% weight-age. The Type Test for these posts was conducted by the Board w.e.f. 20.10.2021 in different phases through NEILT, Jammu/Srinagar. This was followed by the Computer Based Test (CBT), which was conducted by the Board w.e.f. 20.01.2022 to 24.01.2022 in multiple shifts and the score obtained by the candidates was normalized as per the laid down mechanism/procedure adopted by the Board; and

07. Whereas, based on the performance of the candidates in the Skill Test/Type Test (Computer Based) and the Computer Based Written Test (CBT) in accordance with the notified criteria, the JKSSB, vide Notification No. SSB/CoE/CBT/2022/2893-2900 dated 19.03.2022, published the result/score sheet of the candidates. The JKSSB, vide Notice No.SSB/COE/2022/3491-98 dated 30.03.2022, notified the list of candidates falling under consideration zone, who were subsequently called for Document Verification vide No.SSB/CoE/Jr Asst/2022/4327-32 dated 17-05-2022 & Supplementary Document Verification held w.e.f. 17.05.2022 to 19.05.2022; and

08. Whereas, the JKSSB, vide Notification No. SSB/Secy/Jr Asst/2022/5431-38 dated 25.07.2022, in order to fill-up all the requisitioned vacancies, called upon all such candidates who had applied for multiple items/posts to indicate their order of preference(s) for all such posts/items through the online link provided on the official website of the Board www.jkssb.nic.in w.e.f. 26.07.2022 to 01.08.2022; and

09. Whereas, the Board, vide Order No.276-SSB of 2022 dated 08.10.2022, constituted a Selection Committee of various officers/officials to finalize Selection for the aforementioned Posts belonging to various departments; and

10. Whereas, vide Notification No.JKSSB-PLAN/25/2022-03 dated 25.11.2022, the Provisional Selection List of the candidates for the aforementioned posts was notified. However, soon upon the notification of the above Provisional Selection, various representations were received from the candidates pointing out some shortcomings in the notified list; and

11. Whereas, the representations received in the matter were examined and taking into consideration the issues raised by the candidates, the Selection Committee constituted for these posts observed that some changes in the Provisional List are imperative. The matter was, accordingly, placed in the Board for deliberations/decision, which in its 216th meeting held on 26.12.2022, deliberated the matter and approved the Notification of a Revised Provisional Selection List for these posts; and

12. Whereas, in supersession of Notification No.JKSSB-PLAN/25/2022-03 dated 25.11.2022, the Revised Provisional Selection List of the candidates selected (provisionally) for the aforementioned posts was notified vide Notification No.JKSSB-PLAN/25/2022-03 dated 30.12.2022. However, some candidates, aggrieved of the above, approached the Hon'ble Central Administrative Tribunal, Jammu through the medium of OA titled Ranjeet Singh and Ors Vs Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir and Ors seeking following relief:

"Stay the operation of Notification No.JKSSB-PLAN/25/2022-03 dated 30.12.2022 till the final disposal of the above titled OA.

Or

Alternatively, appropriate directions be issued to the respondents No.2 & 3 to accord consideration to the different representations (Annexure-IV) by passing a speaking and reasoned order and also afford a reasonable opportunity of being heard to the applicants and the outcome of the representation so filed may be communicated to the applicants and till then, it is prayed that appropriate directions be issued to the respon-

NHAI to explore use of phosphor-gypsum in construction of national highway

NEW DELHI, Feb 22:

NHAI on Wednesday said it is exploring the use of phosphor-gypsum waste material, a by-product of fertilizer production, in the construction of national highway.

NHAI, along with the Department of Fertilizers, Ministry of Chemicals and Fertilizers, is going to take up field trials on projects for use of phosphor-gypsum in the construction of national highway to achieve a circular economy in the use of gypsum.

An Indian fertilizer company has constructed a road using phosphor-gypsum, which was evaluated by the Central Road Research Institute (CRRI).

Based on their report, the Indian Road Congress (IRC) has accredited neutralised phosphor-gypsum waste material for road construction for three years, National Highways Authority of

India (NHAI) said in a statement.

The fertilizer company and CRRI have been asked to take up field trials on an NHAI project to evaluate performance of phosphor-gypsum on a national highway and to generate confidence among various stakeholders on use of the waste material in highway construction.

NHAI is also encouraging use of waste plastic in road construction, which has already been tested successfully.

Similarly, NHAI has used fly ash -- fine residue of coal combustion in the thermal power plants -- for the construction of highways and fly-over embankments.

NHAI has been encouraging the innovative use of new materials and is focused on reducing the carbon footprint, enhancing durability and making construction more economical. (PTI)

13. Whereas, the Hon'ble Central Administrative, Jammu, vide its Order dated 16.01.2023, disposed of the above titled OA with the following directions:

"In view of the above, the Original Application is disposed of with a direction to Jammu & Kashmir Service Selection Board to publish the final selection list after considering the objections submitted by the aggrieved candidates. Needless to observe that in terms of undertaking given by Mr. Sudesh Magotra, learned Additional Advocate General, the aggrieved candidates shall also be afforded the opportunity of hearing before taking any decision over their objections."

14. Whereas, vide Notice No.JKSSB-LEG/20/2023-03 dated 13.02.2023, the petitioners in the aforementioned OA were afforded an opportunity of being heard before taking any final decision on their objections. 17 petitioners availed the opportunity and attended the office of Secretary, J&K Services Selection Board, at Hema Complex, Sector-3, Channi Himmat, Jammu on 15.02.2023 at 11 AM onwards to present their case/objections to the Revised Provisional Selection List for the aforementioned posts; and

15. Whereas, in deference to the directions of the Hon'ble CAT, Jammu, the representations/grievances of these petitioners were heard/examined and considered by way of Order No.37-SSB of 2023 dated 16.02.2023; and

16. Whereas, various other aspirants, aggrieved of the provision for Normalization Process adopted for the selection of these posts, had approached the Hon'ble Central Administrative Tribunal, Srinagar through the medium of OA 491/2022 titled Attufa Javeed Vs Services Selection Board and the above Provisional/Revised Provisional Selection List was subject to the following directions of the Hon'ble Central Administrative Tribunal, Srinagar, issued vide its interim Order dated 02.06.2022:

"In view of the discussions made above, the Services Selection Board is directed to consider each and every aspect of the present O.A. before finalizing the Selection list and bring out their stand while filing the counter reply. It is made clear that the Final Selection List will not be issued till the next date of hearing..."

17. Whereas, the Hon'ble CAT, Jammu disposed of the above OA vide its Order dated 13.02.2022 with the following directions:

"16. In view of the above, we hold that the respondents were well within their right and jurisdiction while adopting and applying the Normalization process called Equi-percentile Equating method in finalizing the selection process since it was made clear in the scheme of the examination as well as by subsequent notices that this method will be used in the final selection of the candidates.

17. We, therefore, find this OA to be devoid of merit and it is accordingly dismissed. All the MAs stand disposed of. The interim order stands vacated. Respondents are at liberty to proceed further to complete the process of selection and appointment of the candidates as per advertisement notifications and the scheme of examination."

18. Whereas, the Revised Provisional Selection List notified for these posts inter-alia provided that the candidates may represent through the email address jkssbjas-election2022@gmail.com within three days from the date of its

Notification with any grievance. The representations so received from the candidates were examined and those based on merit, have been taken into consideration and necessary changes, where-ever required, have been made while finalizing the selection.

19. Whereas, the Selection Committee constituted for these posts has prepared the Final Selection List for the above said posts in accordance with the merit obtained/eligibility of the candidates and as per the rules in vogue. The candidates who failed to appear before the Document Verification Committee, despite adequate opportunity having been afforded to them in Supplementary Document Verification, have not been considered for selection for these posts. Further, in terms of S.O. 59 of 2020 dated 19.04.2020, the post of Junior Assistant is suitable for following benchmark disabilities:

"Hearing impairment, One Arm, One Leg, Both Legs, Low Vision and Autism, Intellectual Disability, Specific Learning Disability and Mental Illness, Multiple Disabilities."

20. Whereas, the Final Selection List of the candidates for the aforementioned posts was placed in the 220th Board Meeting held on 16.02.2022 at 5 PM, which decided as under:

"The Board perused the record placed before it and taking note of the dismissal of the petition OA 491/2022 titled Attufa Javeed Vs Services Selection Board by the Hon'ble Central Administrative Tribunal, Jammu, approved the Final Selection List prepared by the Selection Committee constituted vide Order No. 276-SSB of 2022 dated 08.10.2022 in respect of 1524 posts of Junior Assistant/Cashier/Clerk/Store Attendant/Cadrex Clerk/ Computer Cum Junior Assistant/Welfare Organizer of various Departments for UT Cadre, Divisional Cadres and various District Cadres, advertised vide Notification No. 04 dated 16.12.2020, No.05 dated 24.12.2020, No.06 dated 29.12.2020 & No.07 dated 31.12.2020 of 2020 & Notification No. 01 dated 03.02.2021, No.02 dated 26.03.2021 & 03 dated 04.06.2021 of 2021 as per Annexure-13A. The Board also decided to return 10 vacancies of Junior Assistant/Welfare Organizer belonging to the Home Department which have remained unfilled for want of eligible candidates."

21. Now therefore, the Final Selection List of the candidates for 1524 posts of Junior Assistant/Cashier/Clerk/Store Attendant/Cadrex Clerk/Computer-cum-Junior Assistant of various Departments for UT Cadre, Divisional Cadres and District Cadres, advertised vide Notification No.04 of 2020 dated 16.12.2020, No.05 of 2020 dated 24.12.2020, No.06 of 2020 dated 29.12.2020 & No.07 of 2020 dated 31.12.2020 & Notification No.01 of 2021 dated 03.02.2021, No.02 of 2021 dated 26.03.2021 & No.03 of 2021 dated 04.06.2021, under various Items, is hereby notified as per the details forming 'Annexure-A to V' to this Notification. Ten (10) vacancies of Junior Assistant/Welfare Organizer, belonging to the Home Department, have remained unfilled for want of eligible candidate(s). It is further ordered that:

- The above Final Selection List shall be subject to outcome of the writ petition(s), if any, pending in the Court of law.
- The List shall also be subject to the outcome of such enquiry, involving any candidate(s), as figuring in this List.
- Formal recommendations to the concerned indenting departments shall be made separately.
- The candidates whose recommendations are kept withheld shall furnish the requisite documents within a period of one month from the date of this notification.

SHOW CAUSE NOTICE
Under Sub-Section 4b of section-52 of the
Indian Forest Act (Amended) 2020.

01. Whereas on perusal of the report of the Range Officer, Soil Range Budgam and after due enquiry and inspection of the seized vehicle by the Range Officer concerned, there are reasons to believe that vehicles bearing Registration No. JK02X/1274, Three Wheeler Auto having Registration No. JK18A/8044 were used in commission of forest offence for transport of forest produce i.e; illicit timber Kail Round to the tune of 14Nos=99.00Cfts which was not bearing Government Hammer Mark and valid transit permit, and which was purportedly brought from Reserve Forests in contravention of provision of section 26 of IFA & Rule 4 of J&K Forest Produce Transit Rules, 2020 read with section 41 & 42 of the IFA.

02. Whereas, Range Officer concerned further reported that the aforesaid vehicles alongwith the illicit forest produce (Timber) was seized on the intervening night of 19th & 20th of February, 2022 by the Territorial Forest Officials of Soil Range Budgam and kept under safe custody at OB post Budgam.

03. Whereas, an intimation was sent to the Hon'ble Chief Judicial Magistrate Budgam as required under section 52(4) of Indian Forest Act 1927 vide No. DFO/PP/Legal/763-64, dated: 23.02.2022 regarding the committed forest offence.

04. Whereas after initiating proceedings, a notice was published in two local leading Newspapers through which interested persons were asked that the case regarding seizure of vehicles alongwith illicit timber is under trial before this Authority and it was impressed upon to appear on 16.03.2022 for recording the statement. On the said occasion no one appeared before this forum but on dated 16.06.2022, two out of five accused persons involved in the instant case were present before this authority and accordingly their statements were recorded. Meanwhile, a series of summonses (By name) were also served from time to time to the persons from whom property was seized in term of section 52(4) of IFA for recording their statements. However, neither anyone turned up to this Court to authorize for the same nor the accused person preferred any claim with respect to seized property during the course of proceedings and till date accused persons who were summoned, didn't bother to appear due to which the case is still pending for final disposal.

Now therefore, in exercise of power conferred under sub-section (3) of section 52 of the IFA, I consider it necessary that the illicit forest produce together with the aforesaid vehicle should be confiscated under above cited section of the Indian Forest Act.

As such, You (Shri 1. Irfan Ahmad Dar S/O Nazir Dar 2. Mohammad Ashraf Dar S/O Kabir Dar R/O'S Drabgam Pulwama 3. Shahid Ahmad Magrey S/O Mohammad Yousuf Magrey 4. Parvaiz Ahmad Khanday S/O Ghulam Khanday 5. Mohammad Ashraf Magrey S/O Mohammad Rafiq Magrey R/O'S Check-e- Keller Shopian) are hereby asked to submit the show-cause as to why the above detailed forest produce together with the aforesaid vehicle should not be confiscated under the law. You are at liberty to make any representation in writing within fifteen (15) days from the date of receipt of this notice. If no representation within the specified period is received, it shall be presumed that you don't want to make any representation against the proposed confiscation of the aforesaid property and order as deemed fit shall be passed in ex-parte thereafter by the undersigned.
