In terms of S.O 364 dated 27-11-2020, applications on plain paper are invited from Non-PSC/ Retired Medical Professional for engagement as Professor, Associate Professor and Assistant Professor on academic arrangement basis in GMC Doda, initially for a period of three years in case of Professor and Associate Professor and for a period of one year in case of Assistant Professor, extendable up to a maximum of six years (one year at a time and subject to good performance and conduct) or till the selection is made in accordance with recruitment rules governing the respective posts, whichever is earlier. Further, the extension after three years shall be made on year to year basis by the Principal, only after approval from the Administrative Department.

The appointees on academic arrangement bases shall be paid a monthly consolidated salary as per the scales defined in the S.O 364 dated 27-11-2020 plus DA and HRA. The Professors, Associate Professors and Assistant Professors appointed in Govt. Medical College, Doda will be entitled to additional monthly incentives of Rs.50,000/-, Rs.45,000/- and Rs.30,000/- respectively.

Staff engaged on teaching post shall be put on teaching and research duties and shall not be assigned any administrative duties at any level, like the position of Principal, Head of the Department and Head of the Unit. The selection of the candidates for such posts shall be made by the respective committee constituted by the Government.

The appointment against the advertised posts shall and shall always be on academic arrangement basis only without conferment of any preferential right on the engages for regular appointment against these posts, which shall be made strictly in accordance with the relevant recruitment rules. The experience gained shall be counted / valid for further promotion / appointment to the higher posts.

The appointment on academic arrangement basis shall by itself stand terminated on attainment of 70 years of age by the appointee. The services of an appointee under these rules shall be terminable before the expiry of the tenure of appointment with one month's notice from either side or on payment of one month's salary in lieu of notice by the appointing authority. In case of any dispute, the decision of Chairperson of the Selection Committee shall be final.

Rare rocks for Lord Ram idol to reach Ayodhya from Nepal

AYODHYA (UP), Jan 28:

Two rare rocks from which the idol of Lord Ram will be carved out and placed in the sanctum sanctorum of Ram Temple will reach here from Nepal on Thursday, a senior functionary of the temple trust has said.

"Vishwa Hindu Parishad's national secretary Rajendra Singh Pankaj started from Mustang district of Nepal on Wednesday with the consignment of two sacred rocks and is expected to arrive in Ayodhya on Thursday," said Prakash Gupta, office in-charge of Shri Ram Jammabhoomi Teerth Kshetra Trust.

"These Shaligram rocks, that are 60 million-years-old, will reach Ayodhya from Nepal on two different trucks. One rock weighs 26 tonnes and the other weighs 14 tonnes," he said.

Idol of Lord Rama in his child form carved from this stone will be placed in the sanctum sanctorum of the Ram Temple, which is expected to be ready by Makar Sankranti festival in January next year, officials said.

The two rocks were found in the Gandaki river at a place close to Saligrama or Mukthinath (place of salvation) in Nepal's Mustang district, they said.

Meanwhile, a two-day meeting of the building construction committee of the Ram Temple began in Ayodhya from Saturday.

The meeting was chaired by construction committee chairman Nripendra Mishra and attended by Trust Secretary Champat Rai and Trustee Anil Mishra.

According to the sources, the progress of the temple construction was reviewed and discussions were held on the installation and carving of the new idol of Lord.

Rai told PTI, "Issues related to temple construction were discussed and this meeting will continue on Sunday also."

The last meeting of the construction committee was held on January 5, and this was the second meeting held in a month. (PTI)

Collaborate in nation building to make India No. 1 in every field by 2047: Shah

HUBBALLI (K'taka), Jan 28:

Union Home Minister Amit Shah on Saturday asked the youth to join hands in nation building and ensure that when the country celebrates its centenary year of independence in 2047, India is number one in every field.

He also called on the youth to take a resolve for progress in their personal lives and also to contribute towards nation building in some field, in this 75th year of independence.

"When we celebrate the centenary year of independence in 2047, in every field this great nation of ours should be number one. To build such a nation, you the youth must join hands on the appeal of PM Modi and contribute in building a great India," Shah said.

Speaking at the platinum jubilee celebrations of B V Bhoomaraddi College and after inaugurating an indoor stadium at the campus, he listed out progress made by the country in various fields and strong foundations laid by the government for develop-

ment in a number of areas.

Karnataka Chief Minister Basavaraj Bommai, who is also an alumni of the college; Union Minister Pralhad Joshi, senior BJP leader B S Yediyurappa, several ministers, and legislators were present at the event.

Asking students and youngsters to read about the freedom struggle and sacrifice made by the people for the country to attain independence, Shah said, "Everyone is not fortunate to sacrifice their lives for the sake of the country like our soldiers do. We may not sacrifice our lives for the country, but we can live our lives for the sake of this nation."

"One should try to attain heights in his or her professional or field of choice, but along with that our aim should also be that India becomes number one in the whole world."

Pointing out that India is today the fifth largest economy from 11th position in the span of last eight years, Shah said it is being predicted that India will become the world's third largest economy by 2027.

"Prime Minister Modi, with this in mind, has a dream for India's youth that India

becomes a (US) five trillion dollar economy. If this happens, technical university students like you will have lots of opportunities," he said.

Highlighting India's growth in the startup space, the Home Minister said there were only three unicorn startups in 2014, but today there are more than 70,000 startups in the country. Seventy-five among them are unicorn startups and 30 per cent of these enterprises are headed by women.

Around 45 per cent of these startups are from Tier-2 and 3 cities, he said, adding that this shows those who have ability can succeed irrespective of the place he or she is in.

Noting the initiatives taken by the Modi government to make India a manufacturing hub and the fifth largest economy today, Shah said patent registration determines any country's future.

In 2013-14, 3,000 patent applications used to come for registration, and now in 2021-22 it has increased to 1.5 lakh applications, he said. Also, the count of registered patents has increased from 211 to 24,000 since then. (PTI)

Whereas, the Govt. of India through Ministry of Road Transport and Highways (MoRTH) Vide Notification No. SO 3840 (E) Dated 16.08.2022 under-section 3A of National Highways Act, 1956 declared its intention to acquire the land particulars of which are mentioned in the schedule for construction of Double Lane Road with paved shoulders on the Existing Double Lane specification Akhnoor- Poonch NH-144A in village Sanai Tehsil Surankote District Poonch.

IAF'S fighter aircraft crash; Pilot killed

NEW DELHI/MORENA/ BHARATPUR, Jan 28:

A Sukhoi 30MKI and a Mirage-2000 aircraft of the Indian Air Force crashed in Madhya Pradesh's Morena district during a routine training mission today, killing a pilot and injuring two who ejected safely.

Officials said the two pilots of the Sukhoi-30MKI aircraft ejected safely while the pilot of the Mirage-2000 lost his life.

"Two fighter aircraft of IAF were involved in an accident near Gwalior this morning," the Indian Air Force (IAF) said in a statement.

It said the aircraft were on a routine operational flying training mission. "One of the three pilots involved, sustained fatal injuries. An inquiry has been ordered to determine the cause of the accident," the IAF said.

Morena District Collector Ankit Asthana said debris of both aircrafts fell in the Pahargarh area of the district. Some debris also fell in the Bharatpur area in Rajasthan, which borders Madhya Pradesh, he added.

The two fighter jets had flown from the Gwalior airport, which also serves as an IAF base, the official said.

Two pilots survived the crash, Asthana said, adding that body parts of another were found in the Pahargarh area.

Earlier in the day, Bharatpur Superintendent of Police Shyam Singh had said an aircraft crashed in an open field in the Uchchain area.

Locals were the first to reach the site where debris from an aircraft fell, police in Rajasthan's Bharatpur had said.

Defence Ministry sources said Defence Minister Rajnath Singh was briefed by Chief of Air Staff Air Chief Marshal V R Chaudhari on the crash of two IAF aircraft.

Singh is monitoring the developments closely, the sources said.

Madhya Pradesh Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan in a tweet said, "The news of the crash of Sukhoi-30 and Mirage-2000 aircraft of the Air Force near Kolaras in Morena is very sad."

"I have instructed the local administration to cooperate with the Air Force in quick rescue and relief work. I pray to God that the pilots of the planes are safe," he said. (PTI)

As per the notification issued here, publication of voter list (Name of Elected Members of District Gurdwara Prabandhak Committees) shall be held on 13 February, 2023.

Election notification in this regard shall be issued on 17 Febru-

ary, 2023, while the last date for filing nomination is 23 February, 2023.

Scrutiny of the nomination papers shall be held on 28 February, 2023 and last date for appeal against rejection of nomination papers is 04 March, 2023.

Last date for withdrawal of nomination papers is 06 March, 2023 while the list of contesting candidates shall be published on 08 March, 2023.

The notice fixing date for holding the meeting of the members of District Committees shall be issued on 09 March, 2023.

Election of members for Board shall be held on 25 March, 2023 and the date for declaration of results shall also be 25th of March, 2023.
