

# Ayushman Bharat first and only scheme in world that gives health coverage to 80 cr people: Amit Shah

BHOPAL, Jan 30: The Ayushman Bharat Yojana, the Centre's flagship health scheme, is the first and only such complete mechanism in the world that provides cover of Rs 5 lakh to 80 crore people, Union Home Minister Amit Shah said on Monday.

Crediting Prime Minister Narendra Modi for this achievement, Shah also said the number of medical colleges had gone up from 387 to 596 across the country since 2014.

He was addressing a function virtually after inaugurating the Shiv Gyan Moti Lal (SGML) Eye Hospital in Ujjain, some 190 kilometres from here.

## Budget session begins today, Prez to address

NEW DELHI, Jan 30:

The Budget session of Parliament begins tomorrow with the maiden address of President Droupadi Murmu to the joint sitting of both Houses.

While the Government's priority will be to seek approval on the Motion of Thanks to the President's Address and the Finance Bill, the Opposition is raring to come it on a range of issues, including the Adani-Hindenburg row, a nationwide caste-based economic census and the women's reservation bill.

Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman will present the last full-fledged Union Budget of the Modi Government before the 2024 Lok Sabha elections on February 1.

The Economic Survey will be tabled tomorrow after the President's address.

The Government plans to bring around 36 bills - including four related to the budgetary exercise - during the session.

The session will have 27 sittings and will continue till April 6 with a

month-long recess to examine the budget papers.

The first part of the session will conclude on February 14. Parliament will reconvene on March 12 for the second part of the Budget Session.

At an all-party meeting convened by it today, the Government said it was willing to discuss every issue under the rules during the Budget Session of Parliament.

"We seek the Opposition's cooperation" in running the proceedings smoothly, Parliamentary Affairs Minister Pralhad Joshi said after the meeting which was attended by 37 leaders, including Defence Minister Rajnath Singh, representing 27 parties.

At the meeting, Aam Aadmi Party's Sanjay Singh, RJD's Manoj Jha, DMK, Left parties and others raised the Adani issue and sought a discussion on it in Parliament during the session.

The US-based short seller Hindenburg Research has accused the Adani Group of wrongdoings like stock manipulation. The company has dismissed the allegations as "nothing

but a lie".

Parties like the BRS and DMK raised the issue of conduct of Governors in States ruled by them.

The YSR Congress demanded a nationwide caste-based economic census.

It is necessary to know the economic status of backward castes which are "lagging behind" on social and development indicators, the party said.

YSR Congress leader Vijaysai Reddy said backward castes are over 50 per cent of the total population and the census will help find their economic status.

The ruling party in Andhra Pradesh has joined the likes of the JD(U) and the RJD, both of which have demanded a caste census.

The grand alliance government in Bihar has rolled out a state-wide caste survey.

Reddy said his party also demanded the passage of the women's quota bill for ensuring reservation for them in Parliament. Parties including the BRS, TMC and the BJD also supported the demand. (PTI)

## Man dies in road mishap, youth succumbs to injuries

JAMMU, Jan 30: A man died in a road accident in Nagrota area of city outskirts while a young boy succumbed to his accident injuries at Government Medical College and Hospital (GMCH), here today.

According to the reports, a man identified as Pawan Kumar (43) son of Sewa Ram, resident of Nagrota, was knocked to death by an unknown vehicle at Jagti (Nagrota). The body of the deceased was sent for post-mortem while Nagrota police had taken cognizance.

Meanwhile, an 18-year-old boy named Sameer son of Mustkeen Khan, resident of Tara Vihar (Paloura) succumbed to his accident injuries in GMCH Jammu at about 2 PM. The victim was hospitalized on January 29 after a motorcycle he was riding got slipped at Bus stand flyover. The body of the deceased was sent for postmortem while concerned police had taken cognizance of the matter.
