 She emphasized that in order to empower women, the first and foremost essential in today's scenario is the implementation of 33 per cent reservation for the weaker sex in the highest temples of democracy i.e. in the Assembly and Parliament.
 The NC women wing leader stated this while addressing the party convention held at Sher-e-Kashmir Bhawan to discuss the issues related to women thread-bare here today. Satwadd Dogra, Provincial President Women Wing, JKNC, Jammu, chaired the convention while NC Provincial President Rattan Lal Gupta and senior NC leader Bimla Luthra were also present on the occasion.
 Shamima castigated the Union Govt as well as the J&K
