NIA attaches property of militant comdr killed in Pak

Centre on October 4 last year under the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act (UAPA) for his role in terror activities.

According to the notification, Pir participated in several online propaganda groups to unite ex-militants and other cadres for the expansion of activities of Hizbul Mujahideen and Lashkar-e-Taiba.

The NIA action follows the attaching of a Srinagar-based property of the founder and chief commander of the Al-Umar Mujahideen, Mushtaq Zargar alias 'Latram', on Thursday, and the attachment of property of The Resistance Front (TRF) operative Basit

Ahmad Reshi in Baramulla district on Friday. The NIA has till date, attached the properties of six designated terrorists - US based Gurpatwant Singh Pannun, Canada based Hardeep Singh Nijjar, and Pakistan based terrorists-Mushtaq Zargar alias Latram, Basit Ahmad Pir, Bashir Ahmad Reshi and KCF (Panjwar) Paramjit Singh alias Panjwar.

The NIA recently attached, under UAPA, the Hurriyat Office in Srinagar, which was owned in part by Nayeem Khan, an accused charge sheeted by the NIA in the Hurriyat terror funding case.

It may be mentioned here that both Dhangri carnage accused in Rajouri district remained untraced even after more than two months of the killings. Seven civilians from minority community, two of them minors, were killed and over a dozen others were injured in attack by two foreign militants at Dhangri on January 1.

"The Intelligence agencies can play very effective role in smashing support system to militants provided through the Over Ground Workers," sources said.

It may be recalled that the Jammu and Kashmir

"The proceeds of the drug trade are utilised to fund terrorism with some of the drug peddlers used as couriers and Over Ground Workers to raise the support structure for terrorists. We are working on a comprehensive level to dismantle the entire support structure of terrorism, which is our duty and we are working on it," he said.

Government had ordered merger of CID (Counter Intelligence) wing with CID (Special Branch) on April 11, 2022.

The CID (Counter Intelligence) wing, which was tasked to tackle anti-national activities, was abolished following constitution of the SIA.

The officers and officials posted in CID (Counter Intelligence) were adjusted in the CID (Special Branch). A total of 199 CID (Counter Intelligence) officials were posted in CI Jammu wing and 183 in Kashmir office. All of them were ordered to report to respective CID (Special Branch) wings, as per an order issued on April 11, 2022.

The order now stands reversed, sources said.

'Cause of action' can't be generated by making repeated representations, legal notices: DB

legal notices served on JDA on 04.02.2014 and 30.04.2016. Thereafter, the respondent filed a complaint before the District Consumer Disputes Redressal Forum alleging deficiency of service.

Consequently, the Forum directed the JDA to allot the plot in favour of respondent subject to payment of Rs 77,400. This was challenged by the JDA by way of an appeal before the J&K State Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, which instead of addressing the appeal on merits, dismissed the same for non-prosecution vide order dated 18.07.2019.

After hearing the counsels for the parties and perusal of record, the DB said, "the order passed by the Forum is not sustainable in law. The plea of limitation specifically raised by the JDA was not decided by the Forum".

The DB further said, the 'cause of action' is not something which can be generated by a party by making repeated representations or legal notices as the 'cause of action' would mean a situation or state of facts that entitles a party to maintain an action in a court of law or a Tribunal; a group of operative facts giving rise to one or more basis for suing; a factual situation that entitles one person to obtain a remedy in court from another person. "The cause of action means

every fact which it would be necessary for the plaintiff to prove, if traversed, in order to support his right to the judgment of the court", the DB said, adding "the legal notices issued by the respondent reiterating his request for allotment of plot which were not responded to by the JDA were issued only as a precursor to the filing of a complaint and with a view to generate fresh cause of action but such course of action is not permitted in law".

"We are of the considered view that the Forum erroneously entertained a highly belated complaint filed by respondent particularly when there was no explanation tendered for such delay. As a matter of fact, the Forum did not advert to the issue of maintainability of complaint being barred by limitation", the DB said.

"So far as the order passed by the Commission is concerned, it is trite law that the Commission, under the Jammu and Kashmir Consumer Protection Act, 1987 had no power to dismiss the appeal for non-prosecution. The Commission ought to have adjudicated the appeal on merits, rather than dismissing it for non-prosecution", the DB said.

Accordingly, the DB allowed the petition of JDA and set-aside the impugned order passed by the Forum.

SC gives green signal for construction of Convention Centre at Patnitop

approached the Supreme Court seeking necessary permissions for the construction of Convention Center at Patnitop, ensuing which, a Central Empowered Committee (CEC) of the Court visited Patnitop in May 2022 to review and assess the steps taken by PDA, Tourism & Forest Departments with regard to the maintenance and restoration of ecological balance and according of permission for the construction

of the Convention Centre. When contacted, Thakur Sher Singh, Chief Executive Officer of PDA said, "it was due to the constant efforts and regular follow-ups by the J&K Government through PDA and Tourism Department that CEC visited the site of the proposed Convention Centre in June 2022, furnished its report before the Supreme Court, which has now granted permission.

India rejects OIC's references on J&K

First Secretary, Permanent Mission of India in Geneva, outrightly rejected the reference to the statement made by the OIC representative.

"As regards the OIC statement, we reject the unwarranted references to the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir," Pujani said in a statement on Friday.

"The fact is that the entire territories of the Union Territories of Jammu and Kashmir and Ladakh have been, are and shall always be part of India. Pakistan is in illegal occupation of Indian territory," she said.

Instead of calling upon its member Pakistan to give up

state-sponsored terrorism and to lift its occupation of Indian territory, the OIC has "let Pakistan hijack and misuse its platform for carrying out its nefarious agenda of engaging in malicious propaganda against India," Pujani said.

India has previously criticised the Jeddah-based OIC for its attempt to interfere and meddle in India's internal affairs as completely unacceptable.

A spokesperson of the Ministry of External Affairs has said that the OIC has already lost its credibility by taking a blatantly communal, partisan and factually incorrect approach to issues. (PTI)

Court extends Sisodia's custody

NEW DELHI, Mar 4:

A Delhi court today extended by two days the CBI custody of former Deputy Chief Minister Manish Sisodia, arrested in a corruption case related to the now-scrapped excise policy, and directed the Central probe agency to produce him on Monday.

Special Judge M K Nagpal also directed the CBI not to ask him the same questions repeatedly after Sisodia termed it as "mental harassment".

"They are not using third-degree. But sitting for eight to nine hours and answering the same questions again and again, that is mental harassment," Sisodia said.

To which the Judge, who had on the last hearing directed the CBI not to use the third degree on the accused, told the probe agency not ask the "same questions again and again. If you have something new, ask him."

During the arguments, Sisodia's counsel also told the court that his wife's health was very poor and that she was basically in a "vegetative state".

"While considering all things, my wife's medical condition has been brushed aside. She is basically a vegetable and her body is degenerating," the counsel said on behalf of Sisodia.

The former Deputy Chief Minister of Delhi made these arguments while opposing the CBI plea seeking his further custody on the ground that he was not cooperating.

The CBI's plea was opposed by Sisodia's lawyer who said the inefficiency of the agency to complete the probe cannot be ground for remand and he cannot be asked to incriminate himself.

"Non-cooperation cannot be a ground for remand. They cannot say we will wait till he confesses. They should have completed the investigation. Their failure to complete investigation can't be a ground for remand," senior advocate Dayan Krishnan, appearing for Sisodia, said.(PTI)

"Pakistan is a State which responds to any calls for reforms with enforced disappearances. In the last decade, Pakistan's own Commission of Inquiry on Enforced Disappearances has received 8,463 complaints. The Baloch people have borne the brunt of this cruel policy," she said.

In her statement, Pujani also expressed regret over a statement made by Turkey at the UN session.

"We regret the comments made by Turkey on a matter that is an internal affair of India and advise it to refrain from making unsolicited comments on our internal matters," she said.

Pujani also spoke about the persecution of religious minorities in Pakistan and asserted that no religious minority can freely live or practice its religion in the Muslim-majority country.

"The Ahmadiya community continues to be persecuted by the

state for simply practicing their faith. To even obtain a Pakistani passport, the community has to denounce its founder. Equally worse is the treatment of the Christian community. It is frequently targeted through draconian blasphemy laws.

"State institutions officially reserve 'sanitation' jobs for Christians. Underage girls from the community are converted to Islam abetted by a predatory state and an apathetic judiciary. Hindu and Sikh communities face similar issues of frequent attacks on their places of worship and forced conversion of their underage girls," she said.

The Indian diplomat said the state's crackdown on those who wish to raise their voice against any of these heinous policies is also incomparable.

"A bill which proposes a five-year jail term for anyone who 'scandalises or ridicules' the military or the judiciary is currently on the table in Pakistan's Parliament," she said. (PTI)
