

Delhi excise policy case ED summons Telangana CM's daughter K Kavitha

NEW DELHI, Mar 8: Enforcement Directorate has summoned Telangana Chief Minister K Chandrashekar Rao's politician daughter K Kavitha in connection with a money laundering case linked to alleged irregularities in the Delhi excise policy, officials said on Wednesday. Kavitha Kalvakuntla, 44, a Bharat Rashtra Samithi (BRS) party MLC, has been asked to depose on March 9 before the federal agency in the national capital. She has been called so that she can be confronted with Hyderabad-based businessman Arun Ramchandran Pillai, an alleged frontman of the "south group", who was arrested by the ED on Monday. The agency will record Kavitha's statement under the Prevention of Money Laundering Act (PMLA) during this confrontation. Pillai is in ED custody and the agency had earlier said he "represented the south group", an alleged liquor cartel linked to Kavitha and others.

The BRS leader said she would fully cooperate with the investigation agency but would seek legal opinion on the date of deposition in view of her proposed dharma in Delhi on March 10 in support of the women's reservation bill. Kavitha said that "these tactics of intimidation" against the fight of her father and Chief Minister K Chandrashekar Rao, and the BRS would not deter them. The ED has Pillai's custody till March 12 (to be again produced before a Delhi court on March 13) and if Kavitha chooses to skip the date on Thursday, the agency may give her a fresh date within the custody period of Pillai. The ED had said the "south group" that "comprises" Sarath Reddy (promoter of Aurobindo Pharma), Magunta Srinivasulu Reddy (YSR Congress MP from Ongole Lok Sabha seat), Kavitha and others. The ED also alleged in Pillai's remand papers that he "represented the benami investments" of Kavitha in this case.(PTI)

Theft case solved, accused arrested

RAJOURI, Mar 8: The police worked out a case of theft and arrested the accused and made recovery of stolen property from his possession. The stolen property recovered valued around Rs 75,000, the police said. Official sources said that police in Rajouri city worked out this case of theft and arrested the accused. It said February 25, an information was received at Police Post City Rajouri that during early morning hours, incidents of theft took place in the town with various packed articles (clothes, shoes) of traders in ward 08, City Chowk and slaughter house area were stolen. The burglar had picked up packed

clothes and shoes. In this connection, a case FIR No. 83/2023 was registered at PS Rajouri and a police team headed by PSI Surjeet Sargotra under the supervision of DySP Hq Chanchal Singh and ASP Rajouri Vivek Shekhar launched investigation. During probe several suspects were picked up and put to sustained questioning and on the basis of human intelligence one person namely Muzahir Hussain (18), son of Makhna, resident of village Dagaani Chingus, at present Jawahar Nagar was zeroed in who during sustained questioning confessed his crime. On his disclosure stolen items have been recovered which include 04 packed articles and boxes having clothes, shoes and few other articles.

Skill, Modern Art Training Centre for females being opened soon: Baru

One killed, 5 injured in road accident

KISHTWAR, Mar 8: One person died and five others were injured here today after a van of Ecco make hit with a bus coming from the opposite direction in Padihyarna area on Kishtwar-Padder road. Of the two injured who were critical and were referred to GMC Doda, one succumbed to his injuries. As per Police the ill fated van bearing registration number JK17-5745 hit the bus bearing registration number JK17A-4412 coming from the opposite leaving the six persons travelling in the van injured who were immediately rushed to DH Kishtwar and from there after first aid the two critically injured Khalid Hussain, 23, son of Abbas, resident of Kiru Kishtwar and Mohd Shafi, son of Chidya, resident of Piyas Galhar were referred to GMC Doda for specialised treatment but Khalid succumbed to his injuries at GMC Doda. The four other injured persons were being treated in DH Kishtwar and were stated to be out of danger till last reports. They have been identified as Sanjay Kumar, son of Om Prakash, resident of Padihyarna; Mansoor Ahmad, son of Sajad, resident of Huller, Kishtwar; Mohd Nadeem, son of Mohd Najam, resident of UP and Ismail, son of Yeel Bakerwal, resident of Piyas.
