

12 students hurt in accident

RAJOURI, May 12: Twelve students were injured when a bus in which they were travelling met with an accident in Nowshera area of district Rajouri today. Official sources said that the bus of TMT School Nowshera met with an accident near Rani Badetar Road, Chingus under the jurisdiction of Police Station Rajouri.

The injured students were shifted to nearby local Health Centre for treatment. Later, one student having suffered multiple leg fractures was shifted to SDH Nowshera. SHO Rajouri Inspector Shoket Hussain along

with his team also reached the spot and shifted injured students to local Health Centre for treatment. Police has registered a case in this connection.

Among injured two students namely, Mohd Waseem, son of Anwar Hussain and Gurtej Singh, son of Sanjay Kumar were shifted to GMC Jammu for further treatment whereas, Mohd Ghulam, son of Anwar Hussain, Sushel Singh, son of Iqbal Singh, Roshni, daughter of Narinder Singh, Ranjeet Singh, Sahil Sharma, Ibrar Ahmed are under treatment in SDH Nowshera. Four students were normal who were discharged after providing first-aid in the hospital.

DC Pulwama, other officers visit Navdal Shrine

PULWAMA, May 12: Taking cognizance of the demand of Temples and Shrines Prabhanda Committee (TSPC), Tral Awantipora which has been demanding restoration of this age old shrine to its pristine glory, a team of district administration Pulwama led by DC Pulwama Basharat Qayoom visited the holy

place and took stock of the situation there.

The DC was accompanied by ADC, Tral, Sajad Yehaya Naqash, Magistrate Tral, Sajad Ahmed, DMO Pulwama, Fayaz Ahmed, PHE and PDD officials.

The TSPC, Tral Awantipora which recently performed Bhoomi Pujan at the Shrine to construct the Navdal Bhawan there and renovate the existing temple has sought the cooperation of administration for restoration of the shrine dating back to Purnic period to its pristine glory.

The TSPC led by its president, Dr Ramesh Bhat had already submitted a memorandum to Divisional Commissioner Kashmir and DC Pulwama in this regard.

The memorandum, while turning attention of authorities towards the holy shrine said the Navdal is the centuries old religious pilgrimage place where the culmination of annual holy Amarnath Ji yatra was taking

place after immersion of relics and taking a holy dip by pilgrims. It said the heritage place due to turmoil and unfortunate conditions in Kashmir got vandalized, encroached and damaged and also trespassed during last three decades.

The memorandum said that the TSPC has proposed to construct Navdal Bhawan with a Yatri Niwas. But due to paucity of

funds the Committee needs the Government support as UT administration under various schemes have provided funds for restorations of shrines and other religious monuments in the Valley.

The Committee demanded construction of a Utility Block near the shrine. Besides, it demanded restoration of the land which has already been encroached and trespassed. It said that this land falling under Kharsa Numbers 407, 388, 475, 476 is yet to be restored from encroachers. Moreover the encroachers have kept their sewage waste outlets towards the shrine which is highly hurting the religious sentiments and this may be stopped immediately.

Deepak Razdhan Project Manger of the shrine said that the visiting team of district administration took stock of the situation and he expressed the hope that soon the land belonging to the shrine will be retrieved.

Govt Degree college student found hanging in hostel room

The students informed the college management and a police team was called. A police team and forensic team reached on spot and collected the evi-

dence to know the cause of suspicious death. SSP Kathua, Shivdeep Singh also reached the spot and inspected the crime scene. He said that the police has registered a case and collected the evidence to know

The family members of deceased reached on the spot and were shocked over the death of their kin. They accused the college management for his death saying he has no reason to commit suicide. They demanded enquiry into the matter.

Three peddlers held with narcotics

JAMMU, May 12: Akhnoor Police today arrested three drug peddlers along with narcotics substance.

"Under the supervision of SDPO Akhnoor Mohan Sharma, a team of Police Station Akhnoor headed by SHO Akhnoor Inspector Harjeet Singh and assisted by PSI Zulfikar during patrolling and frisking of vehicles in TRC area, signaled a vehicle to stop but the driver tried to flee. However, the vehicle was stopped by the alert police party," a Police spokesman said.

He said during search of three persons namely Rajeev Ranjan son of Rampal of Mawa Karoora (Akhnoor), Vinod

Kumar son of Raj kumar of Mawa Karoora and Rahul Kumar son of Rampal of MH Manda (Akhnoor), who were on-board the vehicle, some paper foil used for drug consumption was recovered. On further checking of their Bolero vehicle bearing registration number JK02BG-7179, heroin like substance weighing approximately 4 gram was recovered from it.

"All the three accused were arrested and their vehicle was also seized along with seizure of the recovered narcotics," the spokesman said, adding, a case under FIR number 138/2023 under sections 8/21/22/29 was registered in this connection at Police Station Akhnoor and investigation started.

Sub: Instructions regarding Permission/ Affiliation/ Recognition of Private Schools.

CIRCULAR

Section 11 of Jammu & Kashmir School Education Act 2002 provides that no school shall be established, run or maintained without permission of the Competent Authority. The procedure to be followed for grant of permission to such schools is enshrined in Rule (4) of School Education Rules 2010.

Further Section (12) of the said Act provides that only such private schools, which are recognised shall be permitted to function. These instructions have been issued from time to time for strict compliance by the competent authorities. However, it has been observed that some institutions are still running without permission or undertaking classes/courses for which they have not been permitted in terms of law/rules. Accordingly, it is enjoined upon all the private schools/institutions to:-

- run only after seeking proper permission from Competent Authority through online portal <https://schedujammu.nic.in/pvtschool/>.
- impart education for those courses/classes for which they have been permitted under law/rules.
- display the recognition and affiliation status issued by competent authority on their sign boards.
- register on Adharshila (online monitoring Portal) www.schedujammu.nic.in/adharshila alongwith their recognition/affiliation order and ensure that the error free information of all the students is updated on the portal.
- get Management Committee Certificate renewed after expiry of every 03 years and recognition/permission/affiliation after expiry of every 05 years.

Further, it impressed upon:-

- the parents of the students to ensure that the schools in which their wards are seeking admission are recognized affiliated by Director School Education/Chief Education Officer/JKBOSE/CBSE etc. as the case may be.
- the Chief Education Officer's/Zonal Education Officer's shall ensure that no un-recognized school is allowed to run under their respective jurisdiction. The CEOs shall also ensure that the schools are undertaking only those classes/courses for which they have been permitted by the competent authority under rules.
