

## Vacate Govt land by May 31 or face action: Punjab CM

CHANDIGARH, May 19: Punjab Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann on Friday asked squatters to vacate Government land by May 31 or face action. The ultimatum comes a day after Punjab Rural Development and Panchayat Minister Kuldeep Singh Dhaliwal directed officials to ensure the removal of encroachments from Government panchayat land by June 10. Mann said the State Government is committed to freeing land from squatters and an anti-encroachment drive will begin on June 1. However, if there are houses on such land, people living in them will not be dislocated during the drive, he added. From day one of assuming office, Mann said, his Government had adopted a zero-tolerance policy towards encroachments. He lamented that previous Governments in the state allowed "affluent people" to encroach on Government land by violating norms and termed it "unwarranted and undesirable". (PTI)

#### Terms and conditions:-

- The maximum age on the last date of receipt of application should be 40 years. However relaxation shall be accorded in deserving cases upto 01 year subject to condition that candidate has represented in recognized International Competitions.
- Incomplete application forms without requisite documents shall not be entertained.

- The prescribed eligibility criteria are the minimum and mere possession of the same does not entitle applicant for engagement.

It will be mandatory for each past champion Athlete to register themselves as a Coach on the National Sports repository system (NSRS) portal of SAI @<https://nsrs.kheloindia.gov.in> to become eligible to apply for support under the component.
- Past champion Athletes will be eligible for maximum remuneration of Rs. 3.00 lacs per year subject to the condition that minimum number of trainees should not be less than 30 regular trainees in any given Sports discipline.
- Past champion Athlete will be eligible to avail financial assistance for only one Sports discipline to which that past champion belongs to. However Coaches with NIS certification could also be considered eligible for engagement.
- Each Centre must strive to have equal ratio of male and female trainees.
- Identification of talent pool will be done by respective past champion Athlete in consultation with the Executive Director, SAI of the Regional centre/Divisional Sports Officer of J&K Sports Council.
- The agreement/MOU will be entered between J&K Sports Council and the proponent before start of coaching.
- The Khelo India Centre, Sub Scheme would be run for a period of 4 years coinciding with the Olympic Cycle and Coterminal with Khelo India Scheme.
- Minimum academic qualification should not be less than Matric.
- The Coaching Experience shall be entertained from Government Institutions/SAI/Recognized National Sports Federations/UT Associations on payroll basis.
