JAMMU, May 24: As the Special Investigation Unit (SIU) today conducted simultaneous raids at the residences of eight terrorists in Kishtwar and Ramban districts who have been operating from

Pakistan and Pakistan occupied Jammu Kashmir (PoJK), the Union Home Ministry is expected to approach Interpol for initiating action against some of the nearly 250 such terrorists hailing mostly from three districts of the Jammu

region.

"Police and Intelligence agencies have identified 250 terrorists hailing from Kishtwar, Doda and Ramban districts who after their exfiltration to Pakistan and PoJK have been operating from there trying to mobilize local youth to revive militancy in the three districts by carrying out terror strikes," the officials told the Excelsior.
