Reasi a sensitive place, devise joint area domination plans for district: DGP

JAMMU, Sept 7: Describing Reasi as a sensitive place as it is connected with the border district of Rajouri as well as to the Valley, Director General of J&K Police Dilbag Singh today directed for devising joint area domination plans for the District with involvement of Village Defence Groups (VDGs) for monitoring and generation of human intelligence.

He said this while interacting with Police personnel who were part of yesterday's encounter in which a Pak terrorist was eliminated at Chasana in Reasi District of Jammu Zone. The DGP said that because of the location of Reasi, there may be attempts of cross over from one district to another and as such, all the forces should continue to work together to foil such attempts. He directed the officers to be vigilant on all fronts particularly while keeping track of movements of anti national elements and their supporters.

The DGP also directed for taking stringent actions against the people found involved in providing any kind of support to terrorists. He directed all officers to monitor activities of all suspects besides the elements attempting to revive the terror structure from across the border.

Accompanied by ADGP Jammu Zone, Mukesh Singh, the DGP was received by DIG Udhampur-Reasi Range M Suleman Choudhary; SSP Reasi Amit Gupta and other jurisdictional officers.

While interacting with the Jawans and officers at Chasana, the DGP appreciated the swift move and alertness by the SHO Chasana and I/C Police Post Tuli and their teams to track down the terrorist in the area.

He said that this kind of action is being expected at all levels from the professional force like Jammu and Kashmir Police. He said that response to the information regarding movement of terrorists was quick and efficient.

For such swift action, the DGP presented rewards to the police party that was part of the encounter. "Work in similar manner and don't allow any chance to Pak backed terror groups in the area," the DGP impressed upon the personnel.

Dilbag Singh said that J&K Police is working day in and day out in providing peaceful environment to the people and added that by and large peace is flourishing in all parts of J&K. "We have to continue our efforts in a mission mode to realise the terror free Jammu and Kashmir," he added.

The DGP said that with the support of local people, security forces foiled several infiltration attempts along the Line of Control (LoC) in Poonch-Rajouri belt of Pir Panchal in the Jammu region, besides seizing huge consignments of arms, explosives and narcotics.

The DGP said that J&K Police alongwith other security forces are fully alert and working in tandem to put an end to terrorism in Jammu and Kashmir. He said the border security grid is "much stronger than ever to scuttle any attempt from Pakistan to push terrorists and smuggle arms and narcotics. He also stressed upon jurisdictional officers for taking stringent action against the people found involved in narco-trade.

The DGP also interacted with officers and Jawans of 33 RR based at Chasana and also took briefing on operational aspects in the area.

SRINAGAR, Sept 7: In a remarkable feat of efficiency, the Government Medical College (GMC), Baramulla, today achieved the second-highest nationwide ranking for OPD token generation through the ABDM's Scan & Share Queue Management System.

According to official statistics, GMC Baramulla recorded an impressive 1,297 OPD tokens in a single day, securing the second position across the country. The top spot was held by the Government General Hospital in Karnataka, which surpassed the 1,500 mark.

Dr Parvaiz Masoodi, GMC Baramulla, celebrated this achievement, saying, "It is indeed a great

achievement, earlier, the hospital remained at number 4 in token generation. Now, there has been a significant improvement, with the hospital jumping to number 2. Further improvement and an increased number of registrations will be ensured in the days to come for better and hassle-free patient care."

This accomplishment comes on the heels of J&K's second-place ranking in token generation nationwide during August, with nearly 300,000 tokens generated in a single month.
